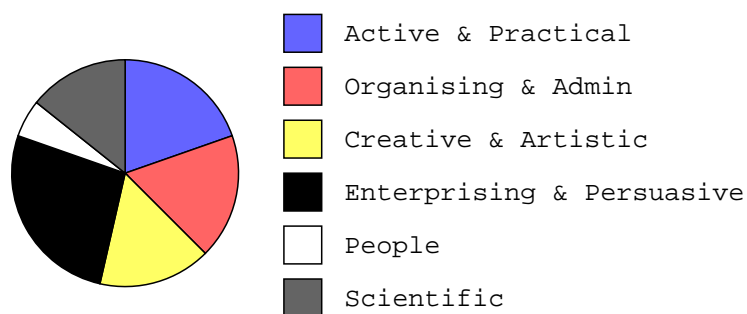
Quizzes 5-10 : Areas of Work

Each of these quizzes relates to a particular broad area of work -

- Quiz 5 - Active and Practical
- Quiz 6 - Organising and Administration
- Quiz 7- Creative and Artistic
- Quiz 8 - Enterprising and Persuasive
- Quiz 9 - People
- Quiz 10 - Scientific and Investigative

Your scores have been calculated from the number of answers to which you gave a "YES" in each individual quiz.

The pie chart below shows the 6 areas of work, divided up according to how many times you answered "YES" in each work area.



Your results show that you seem to have clear ideas about what you want to do in the future. Check out the skills and qualifications needed for the areas where you have scored highest and make sure that they match your own ideas. And just remember that your ideas may change over the next few years, so if you are choosing school/college subjects, go for a broad range.

The colours used in the "YOUR RATING" column are like traffic lights :

- Green for "YES" (a good positive response)

- Red for "NO" (a danger sign and you definitely need to think about these, as you are saying no to an important aspect of the work!)
